# BEFORE AND AFTER SCHOOL CARE AND VACATION CARE

Camp Australia is the provider for Northbourne Public School. Before and after school care is offered to children Kindergarten to Year 6, providing a safe, caring and homely environment with trained and dedicated staff committed to the individual needs of your child and family.

#### **BOOK CLUB**

All children are offered membership to the Scholastic Book Club. The aims of the Club are:

- ♦ to encourage children to read for enjoyment,
- ♦ to bring parents, children and books together,
- ♦ to aid teachers to bring a wide variety of childrens literature into the classroom, and to provide books designed to appeal to children of all abilities at reasonable prices. Order forms are sent home once per term. There is no obligation to purchase.

# CANTEEN

Our canteen operates in line with the NSW Healthy School Canteen Strategy and is open Monday to Friday for lunch orders and over the counter sales. Lunches must be ordered before 9am through Flexischools. A limited menu is available for orders between 9am and 10:30am.

# LIBRARY

All students have a weekly library period. Children learn technology and information skills and develop a love of literature through lessons in the library. Kindergarten to Year 6 students are encouraged to borrow regularly either during class lessons or during lunch time. Parental support of the library program ensures the development of students' information literacy. Any resources borrowed must be contained in a library bag to protect the items. Library bags may be purchased from the online uniform shop, or one can be made at home. Damaged books/resources must be returned for library personnel to repair. Damaged or lost resources must be paid for by parents. The library is open at lunchtime Thursday & Friday for recreational purposes, research, quiet reading and borrowing.

# LUNCH AT SCHOOL

At this school all students from Kindergarten to Year 6 eat their lunch in their classrooms with their class teachers. This ten-minute eating period is provided to ensure students eat their lunch. Students are then dismissed to go out to the playground to play, attend choir, dance rehearsals, sport training sessions, SRC Meetings, timeout or any other commitment they may have. Therefore, students who need to purchase their lunch from the canteen MUST order their lunch before 9am. The lunches are sent to the classroom for the designated lunch eating time.

# MONEY COLLECTION

The preferred payment for events is through Schoolbytes.

Additionally, cash payment can be made through the front office.

#### PARKING IN SCHOOL GROUNDS

Parents are to drop off and pick up their children outside school grounds. Parking on school grounds is strictly for staff and deliveries only. Please observe the traffic signs in the streets around our school. All students have a right to be safe.

# PRESCRIBED MEDICATION

Medication is administered only at the school office. Students are to go to the office at the appropriate time to take their medication.

# REPORTING TO PARENTS

Meet the Teacher information sessions are presented early in Term 1 where teachers outline the coming year's work and class procedures. Individual parent/teacher interviews are held at the end of Term 1 and as needed throughout the year. School reports are emailed to parents through Schoolbytes towards the end of Terms 2 and 4.

# **SCHOOL HOURS**

It is vital that students arrive promptly and ready to learn. School starts at 8:30am and finishes at 2:30pm. Students in Kindergarten and Year 3 & 4 have their recess 10-10:30am and lunch 12:30-1:00pm. Years 1, 2, 5 & 6 students have recess 10:30-11:00am and lunch 1-1:30pm.

- > Playground supervision commences at 8:00am.
- > Students are not permitted to leave school grounds during the day unless accompanied by a parent. A parent request, in writing, for alternate arrangements should be sent to the school.
- Parents who wish to take children from school early (without written request) need to sign them out at the office, the office will call for the child to be sent down.
- Children who are late should report to the office for a late note before attending class.

# SICK BAY

If a student comes down to sick bay, staff will assess the child and if required will contact the parents to collect them. If the child is okay, we will send them back to class. If a child has any injury above the shoulder a call will be made. An email notification will be sent home each day for any child that has visited sick bay.

#### SCHOOL HATS

Hats are compulsory as our school has a SunSafe Policy to protect your child from the possible damage caused by the sun. Children without a hat are expected to play in the shade.

# SPECIAL RELIGIOUS EDUCATION / SPECIAL ETHIC EDUCATION

Volunteer teachers visit the school each Tuesday for 30 minutes to give the students from Kindergarten to Year 6 the opportunity to be involved in Special Religious Education / Special Ethic Education instructions.
